
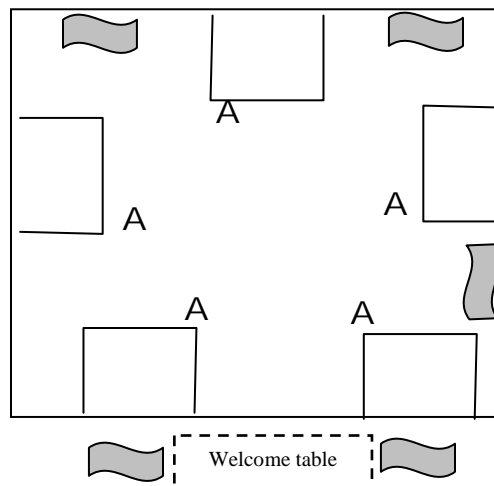

EXHIBIT SPACE REQUIREMENTS: Block Fest consists of 5 block building stations, each of which requires an 8X10 space, with 3-4 feet between stations. A complete instruction manual included in the exhibit outlines all details about the set-up. See below for a sample illustration in a room approx. 40' x 24':

Stations can be arranged in a circle as shown, or in any other formation that fits your space. In addition to the stations, there are 5 free-standing banners (3'wide x 8' tall () that are best positioned near a wall and 5 freestanding A-frame signs (18"wide x 3' tall [A]). Each 8'x10' station is defined by 20 (2'x2') foam squares that link together.



VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

- Set-up and inventory: 2-3 people for about 1.5 hours.
- Station attendants: 5 people - 1 volunteer per station to monitor and facilitate child and adult's play and learning. Small groups (fewer than 20 children) can get by with fewer volunteers.
- Take down, inventory and pack up: 2-3 people for about 1.5-2.5 hours.
